SHIPMENTS

Since the beginning of this Rotary year, MSNI has made shipments to Mexico, South Africa and the Philippines as well as providing equipment and supplies to local organizations.

The Mexico shipment was picked up by Rotarian Charles Campbell of the Broken Arrow, Oklahoma, club. Charles and fellow Rotarians then drove the shipment to its final destination. The cost of transporting the shipment from Tulsa to its final destination was sponsored by the Broken Arrow club.

The South Africa shipment was sent to the Rotary club of Kirstenbosch in the Cape Town area. This was the second shipment made to this area by MSNI and was paid for in part by the Rotary club of Kirstenbosch and a sponsor obtained by the Universal Heart Organization.

The Philippines shipment was a follow-up to a shipment sent to that area in June of last year. Among the items included in this shipment were dialysis machines that Director of Operations Larry Biron noted were needed on his earlier trip to the Philippines when he coordinated the distribution of the original shipment. This shipment was sponsored by the

Shiraki Memorial Foundation. This sponsorship was obtained by Stan Togikawa, a Rotarian from Honolulu, Hawaii.

During the month of November, MSNI will be sending a container to Nicaragua. This shipment is in conjunction with the Rotary Club of Tulsa's water well project. This shipment will contain drilling equipment, pipe and other materials needed for the project. In addition, MSNI will fill the balance of the container with as much medical equipment and supplies as possible.

BOARD MEMBERS ELECTED

Each year at our annual meeting held during the District Conference board members are elected to serve a three-year term. The terms are staggered, which means one third of the board is elected annually. This year the membership elected Dr. Harry Livingston, Tulsa (OK) Rotary Club; Herb Orr, Sunrise Rotary Club – Tulsa, OK; Charles Keeter, Joplin MO; Dr. Randy Weiss, Joplin (MO) Daybreak; David Webb, Ft. The new board then met and elected its officers for next year. The new term for these officers begins in January 2008 and ends December 2008. The new

president will be Kelly Rector, Parsons KS; vice president elect is Daniel Leis, DDS, Rogers (AR) Early Risers; treasurer will be Ben Windham, Tulsa OK; secretary will be Randy Weiss, Joplin (MO) Daybreak.
