During the first quarter of this Rotary year, MSNI delivered a land trailer to Belize. This shipment was coordinated by Board member David Webb of the Fort Smith Rotary Club. Additionally, a 40-foot container was sent to Bulgaria. This shipment was sponsored by the First United Methodist Church organization. The September shipment was scheduled for Ecuador. Unfortunately, they were unable to procure funds for this shipment. This shipment will be diverted to another location based on the availability of funds.

Additionally, MSNI provided \$16,180 worth of equipment and supplies to local District charities.

The value of shipments for the first quarter is \$206,120.
