### SHIPMENTS

Another banner year for MSNI! During our last Rotary year, MSNI shipped more than \$1 million worth of medical equipment and supplies to developing countries and provided more than \$42,000 of medical equipment and supplies to local charities throughout our District.

Shipments were made to Belize, Bulgaria, the Philippines, Ecuador, Nicaragua, Mexico and South Africa. Some of these areas received more than one container during the year.

The shipping cost for the Philippine shipments was paid for by the Shiraki Memorial Foundation from Honolulu, Hawaii. The two shipments to South Africa were paid for through District 6110's Simplified Grant Program. All the other shipments were funded individually. To date, MSNI has shipped 140 sea containers since its inception.

### CAR RAFFLE UPDATE



We have reached our halfway point date-wise in the sale of the raffle tickets. To date, we have sold approximately 1400 tickets for the raffle. This year's goal is to sell a minimum of 2,500 tickets but no more than 3,000 tickets.
